Young Audiences of Western New York's ArtWorks program is a multi-disciplinary, arts-based job training program for Teen Youth Apprentices ages 14-18, or freshman to senior grade level, in the City of Buffalo and Erie County. Through workshops, a cohort of teen apprentices will engage in arts activities and projects, led by a Master Teaching Artist, while learning workforce readiness skills. There will be professional development workshops, as well as guests and trips to various Buffalo arts and cultural sites.

The ArtWorks program consists of a Spring Session (March 4-May 28, 2019), a Summer Session (July 8-August 16, 2019), and a Fall-Spring Session (September 2019-May 2020).

This will be a \$12/hour paid position, with commitments and expectations that meet those of a regular job. You will be required to attend ALL scheduled sessions AND the full day sessions on select days on school breaks.

The program is located at the Buffalo & Erie County Central Public Library, at 1 Lafayette Square, Buffalo, NY 14203. **PARTICIPANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING THEIR OWN TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM THE PROGRAM**

The Spring 2019 session (March 4 - May 28, 2019) will be on Mondays and Tuesdays, 3:30-6PM. The art focus will be on mural arts.
