Followed by 84% attending outdoor events, 74% attending non-traditional venues, 69% attending nature centers or gardens, 58% attending film and media arts events, 55% attending the zoo or aquarium, 49% attending science or children's museums, and 41% attending workshops



attended outdoor events in-person since March 2020

Followed by 33% attending museums and nontraditional performing venues, 24% attending nature gardens and 24% who have not attended any in-person events since March 2020

are fully vaccinated (out of 229 responses)



84% live in Erie County 10% from Niagara County 4% from Chautauqua County

Less than 1% of responses came from Wyoming, Genesee, Monroe, and Allegany counties




