Jeremy Rowe, a lifelong Buffalo resident, has an idea for a film project presenting public opinion and you are invited to be in it!

In between calling plays, coaching basketball full time throughout the Buffalo community, Jeremy Rowe often converses with Buffalo, NY residents about the mayoral race. He came to the conclusion that much of the city's population is divided in threes! One third is firmly behind Mayor Byron Brown, happy with how the current mayor has represented the city. One third is all for primary winner India Walton, yearning for the changes that Walton promises. There is also another third, made up of individuals that either do not like either candidate, or don't really seem to care because they don't see Buffalo being helped by either candidate.

At this point, Rowe contacted his family member and filmmaker Korey Green (The Forgotten City 2006, The Romans 2014, The Blackness Project 2018). He pitched the idea of interviewing Buffalo residents on how they feel about the upcoming mayoral race Brown vs Walton. Green simply said "Okay, let's do it!"

From this idea we present: "3 Buffalos" This film project will be an interactive documentary that focuses on views from the 3 different perspectives: supporters of Brown, supporters of Walton, and the undecided.
