The NACC Gallery Committee is pleased to announce our Native Voices 2021. This Native American Arts Exhibition at the NACC will showcase the many talented Native American artists in our area. To allow the exhibition to represent a wide range of artistic mediums it will not be limited to a specific genre or medium, therefore, we will accept two-dimensional and three- dimensional works of art with a limit of 4 pieces per artist. This exhibition is open to any Native American artist who lives or works in New York State. Prizes will be awarded for Traditional, Contemporary, Avant Garde, and Viewer's Choice categories.

Native Voices 2021 opens on Sunday October 17, 2021 and runs through November 26, 2021. Awards will be presented at noon on Sunday November 21, 2021 during the closing of our 2-day celebration weekend event, celebrating Native American Heritage Month. This art exhibition will work to support this immersive two-day celebration at the Niagara Arts and Cultural Center, being held on November 20 - November 21. This weekend will showcase the Native American culture with music, exhibits, dance, theater, films, a fashion show, panel discussion and keynote speakers.

Submission: Complete the entry application and submit to the email listed below. Provide at least 1 photo sample of each art/work being submitted, and all completed information. All entries must be original to the submitting artist. Work must be professionally mounted and framed. The Gallery Director will review the work and notify you by email- by October 1 if you have been accepted into the show.

Deadlines:

• **Entry Deadline:** September 26, 2021 – your entry paperwork and digital images/proposal of your work must be submitted.

• Notice of Acceptance: October 1, 2021 – you will be informed via email if your work has been accepted to this exhibit by this date.

• **Drop-Off Deadline:** October 8 – your artwork must be dropped off at the NACC. NACC hours Monday - Sunday 12-5 PM. To make other arrangements contact <u>Liz@thenacc.org</u>

Exhibit Fee: There is no fee to enter this show as this is a juried exhibition.

Reception: Native Voices 2021 on the 1st floor of the NACC, in the Townsend Gallery, on October 17th from 12:00pm-2:00pm.

Awards: The entries will be juried by the NACC's Gallery Director and Native Voices Gallery Committee. Viewer's Choice Award will be chosen by the gallery visitors and patrons. Ballot votes will be accepted until November 20th at 5pm. All winners will be announced on November 21, 2021 at noon.

Pick Up: Art must be picked up November 28, 2021 by 5pm; the NACC is not responsible for artworks that remain in our space after November 28, 2021. Artworks may be discarded or donated for auction or sale. To make alternate arrangements contact <u>Liz@thenacc.org</u>

General Information

- Please submit work that is for sale, however we will accept pieces listed as "Not for Sale" for this show only.
- Please price your artwork to include a 25% commission for NACC in your sale price.
- Prizes will be awarded on November 21, 2021; checks will be mailed to winners within 15 business days.
- Entry fee is waived for this show. (Four (4) piece maximum).

Eligibility for Gallery Exhibit

• This exhibition is open to all Native American artists working or living in New York State. All artwork must be original and created by the artist. Instructors or mentors who assisted, touched up or worked on pieces should be credited.

• Our Gallery uses a wire hanging system. Two-dimensional works must be <u>wired and framed</u> for hanging or <u>mounted</u> for display. Sawtooth, Arrow, Push pins, D-Ring, Hang Tabs, & Command Strips/Hooks are not accepted as they do not work with the system installed in the Gallery. Sculptures/Works that cannot stand on their own will not be accepted. Submitted works that do not meet this requirement will be omitted from the exhibit.

• The NACC will not alter or repair pieces that are not "hang-ready" upon arrival. Artworks that are warped, damaged, or deemed not suitable for display will be omitted from this exhibition.

• Three-dimensional sculptural works must be free standing with a clean, non-abrasive base or mounted on a pedestal.

Entry Guidelines

- Complete the online entry or paper entry form.
- All mediums of artwork will be accepted.
- You will be notified if your work will be included in the Gallery Exhibit.

• If applicable: Entry fees can be paid with cash, or by check or money order made payable to Niagara Arts and Cultural Center and mailed to: NACC, 1201 Pine Avenue, Niagara Falls, NY 14301. PAYMENT IS DUE UPON DROP OFF - Artworks will not be accepted without full entry payment.

Drop-Off Procedures

• All entries must include a label on the back or underside that includes the following information: NAME OF ARTIST, TITLE OF WORK, ARTISTIC MEDIUM and PRICE. Artwork WILL NOT be accepted without proper labeling.

• Two-dimensional works must be <u>wired and framed</u> for hanging or <u>mounted</u> for display. See eligibility section for details.

• Drop off work during NACC hours: Monday through Sunday from 12 am to 5 pm. If you would like to drop off or pick up artwork at any other time, please contact <u>Liz@thenacc.org</u> to make an appointment that is more convenient for your schedule.

Gallery Policy:

The NACC Gallery Committee reserves the right to refuse artworks that do not follow exhibition guidelines, including but not limited to artworks that do not pertain to the exhibition theme and requirements or have been found unbefitting of the intent of the exhibition.
